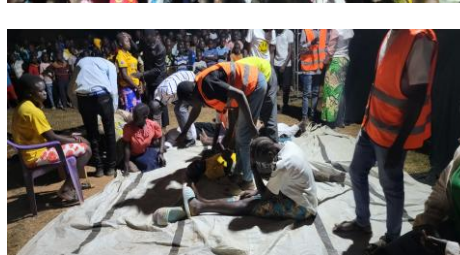

■ Batali Peter (22 Years)

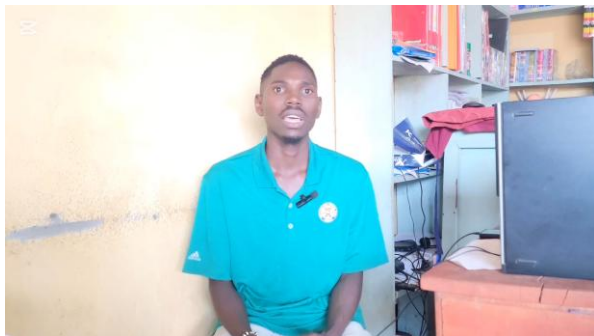

■ Malish Alex (24 Years)

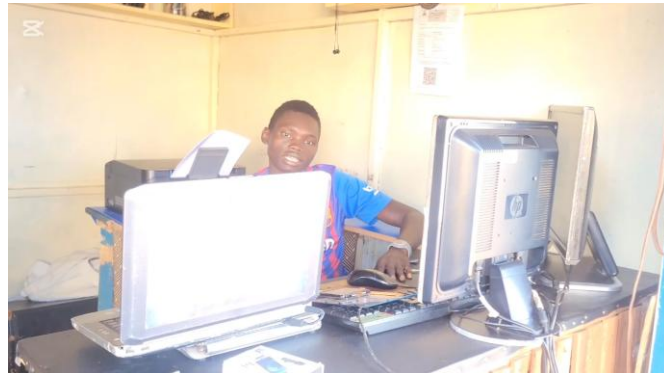
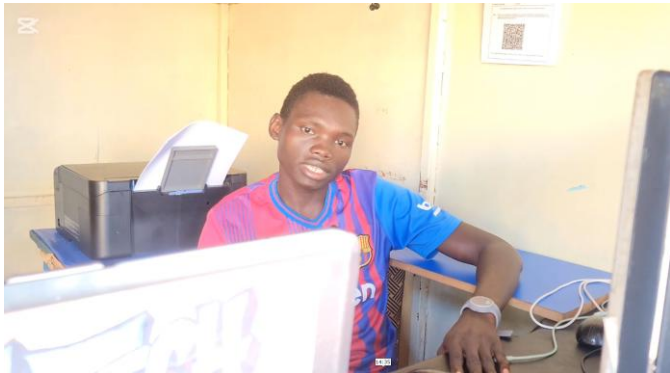
